The Future of Horton and Chalbury churches - BEETLE PROJECT Update

This important project is slowly moving forward. The initial teams of volunteers (following our very successful open meeting in Horton & Chalbury Village Hall on March 3rd) are now almost formed and we hope they will start working on their specific areas very soon.

The PCC has appointed Marcus Chantry (a Specialist Conservation Architect) and he is visiting both churches again in early June. His report will specify a phased plan of action, and we hope to instigate the first phase as soon as possible. This will use money some of which has already been set aside, but fund-raising activities will certainly follow rapidly so **WATCH THIS SPACE!**
