The Trustees and Staff at the MARS Trust are passionate about young people and our desire is to see them thrive in the ever-changing complex world of relationships.

The Board of The MARS Trust is seeking a new Chair of Trustees to start the full volunteer role in July 2022.

The charity is founded on Christian principles and the new chair will be a practising Christian. The Board has 6 members and there are 3 part-time staff, a CEO, Operations Manager and Development Officer.

Funding is raised principally from grant making bodies with additional donations from local churches, individuals and fundraising events.

To facilitate this growth, we are currently developing a brand new scenario based learning initiative and a 6th Form programme.
