Minster open. The Minster is now open for tourism and private prayer on **Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday** of each week, from **10.00am – 4.00pm**. We hope to extend our opening to include more days of the week, depending on the availability of volunteer vergers.

Starting at **11.15am** and aiming to finish between 12.00 and 12.15pm.

I was able to get \$1,000 to Yambio, South Sudan last week via Archbishop Samuel Peni. The money was from donations from the Minster & money raised from recycled greeting cards made by Jill Beech & her team from St Michael's Colehill. Archbishop Samuel's response was "Greetings to you in the name of Jesus Christ our Lord and Saviour, Amen. Thank you so much for your generous gifts to the needs of the people of South Sudan. I have given 400 dollars to Bethsaida Parish towards construction of their church building. The money will go to buy beam materials. 200 dollars for the IDP from Tambura and the rest for fuel and maintenance of the car. Thank you so much. May God bless you."
