**Salisbury Sudan Medical Link.** (SML) On behalf of all at SML and the clinics in Maridi, Yamboi, Nzara and Ezo, I do want to thank you all so very much indeed who contributed to our funds. Thanks to your generosity and Anne Pollard`s enthusiasm and organisation with the "tea parties" you have already raised over £808. There is still time to help further by writing a cheque to: Salisbury DBF (Medical Link). This money along with other money raised will soon be enough to supply these clinics with essential Malarial and Antibiotic drugs in time for Christmas. We only need another £1,000, approximately, to make the consignment economical as we have to fly in the medicines. I shall be **talking and showing** about 120 pictures from Sudan for 3/4 hour on Zoom on **Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> November at 6.00pm** essentially for people who missed the "Zoom" in April. N.B.
