Peace Haven: Homes for Refugees

Concerned residents of Wimborne are spearheading an initiative to house refugees. The idea came from a member of the local Methodist church who was moved by the plight of Ukrainians fleeing their homeland. Our aim is to pay the rent on two properties - a flat for Ukrainians and a larger property for an Afghan family. International Care Network - a Dorset charity which has been settling refugees in the area for over 20 years - will support both families. We are asking for people to pledge £10 (or a multiple thereof) a month for a year and we hope to have enough pledges to move forward with the scheme.
